### NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a regular meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, March 24, 2026, at 11:00 a.m.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Approval of the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Directors held on February 24, 2026;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports, and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
4. Consider review of draft operating budgets for Fiscal Year ending May 31, 2027, and authorize distribution of draft budgets to other Participants under that certain Contract for Financing, Operation and Maintenance of Master Water and Sanitary Sewer Facilities with the District for review and approval;
5. Receive Tax Assessor-Collector report and approve payment of invoices presented and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
6. Report on legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, authorize foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
7. Authorize consultants to research unclaimed property and consider authorizing bookkeeper and tax assessor-collector to prepare Unclaimed Property Report(s) as of March 1, 2026;
8. Operator's Report, including:
  - a) Monthly report, including inspections, repairs and maintenance of District facilities and status of compliance with permits;

  - c) Status of air scouring program, and authorized necessary action in connection therewith;
  - d) Status of SediVision program, and authorize necessary action in connection therewith;
  - e) Status of KETOS monitoring program, and authorize necessary action in

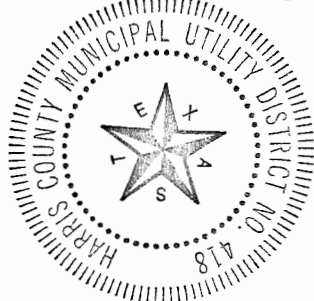
- connection therewith, including review and approval of renewal agreement for services;
- f) Discussion regarding installation of smart meters, and take necessary action in connection therewith;
- g) Site security improvements;
- h) Approval of 2026 water loss audit and authorize filing of same with Texas Water Development Board; and
- i) Authorize operator to prepare and file water conservation plan annual implementation report with the Texas Water Development Board;



- b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295's in connection therewith including:

Conduct annual review of Connection Charge calculations prepared by Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 418 (the "Master District") pursuant to that certain Contract for Financing, Operation and Maintenance of Master Water and Sanitary Sewer Facilities by and between the District and the Master District, and adoption of a Resolution regarding same;
12. Report on status of storm water pollution prevention and storm water quality management; including status of storm water permits and the taking of any action relative thereto;
13. Matters related to the Bridgeland Water Agency (the "Agency") and directives to the District's Trustee and Alternate(s), including discussion regarding participation of the District's operator in Agency meetings;
14. Updates and revisions to District website, including status of website administration through Touchstone District Services, LLC;
15. Developer's Report;
16. Annexation of certain land into the boundaries of the District, including proposed annexation of approximately 82.90 acres as requested by Bridgeland Development, L.P.;
17. Attorney's Report; and
18. Schedule of future meetings and matters for possible placement on future agendas.
